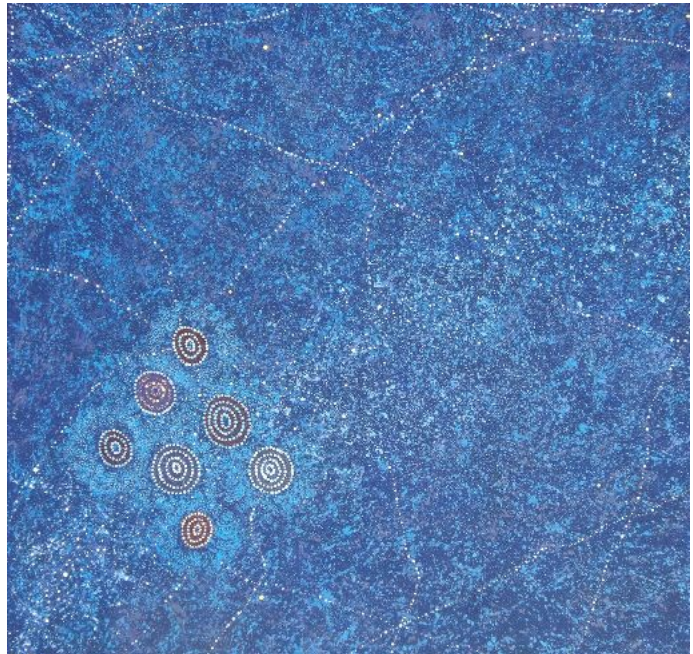
Dreamtime

'Dreamtime' an Aboriginal art exhibition.

Dreamtime, for the Aborigines, is the beginning of knowledge from which came the laws of existence. It is also the beginning of time, when the supernatural ancestor beings were 'born out of their own territory'.

Warlukurlangu Artists are considered to be the founders of the Australian Aboriginal desert art movement, often called 'dot painting.' They are renowned for their sophisticated use of colour, and the way they illustrate their mythical stories of the earth's creation from the Dreamtime.

More than 60 paintings will be on show from 22 nd October 2009 - 20 th November 2009 at La Fontaine. Opening night is exclusively for sponsors and tickets holders of the concert by the Japanese 'Takht': Le Club Bachraf.
